

Best of Europe 14 Days

Day 01 : India – London – London Eye – Madam Tussauds Wax Museum (UK)

Arrive at London airport, where you will be greeted by your Tour representative and then proceed to your hotel and check-in. After lunch depart to visit the Swaminarayan Temple at Neasden. After temple visit, we will visit Madame Tussauds Wax Museum where you can see world famous personalities in wax Statue like Bollywood Stars Amitabh Bachhan and Aishwarya Rai. After Wax Museum, visit the London Eye for a spectacular view of the city. Enjoy a delicious dinner at an Indian restaurant. Later, check into your hotel.

Day 02 : London city Tour – Euro Star – Paris City Tour.

After breakfast depart for City Tour of London with English speaking local guide which includes: Buckingham Palace, Hyde Park, the Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Houses of Parliament, Trafalgar Square, Piccadilly Circus, Tower Bridge, the River Thames and more. Later proceed board your Euro Star train from London to Paris. Arrive Paris and depart for guide city tour of Paris, where you will be show you many of the best-loved Parisian sights – Alexander Bridge, Arc de Triomphe, Concorde Square, House, Invalides, Champs de Elysees and many more.

Day 03 : Eiffel Tower – Brussels.

After breakfast check out and depart to see Eiffel Tower. The tower stands 324 meters (1,063 ft) tall, about the same height as an 81-storey building. From top you can see magnificent view of Paris City. Later, proceed to Brussels to visit the world renowned Grand Place and the legendary Mannequin Piss statue. Drive past St. Michael's Church. A photo stop at the Atomium is also included. Tonight, enjoy an Indian dinner and then check into your hotel.

Day 04 : Brussels – Madurodam - Amsterdam.

After breakfast depart to visit Madurodam. In miniature city Madurodam you will see the well-known buildings and scenes in The Netherlands replicated on a scale 1:25. The Parliament buildings of The Hague, the canal houses of Amsterdam, the Alkmaar cheese market and little trees and gardens, all replicated in minute detail. Windmills turn, ships sail and modern trains are tracer sing the city on the world's largest miniature railway. Later depart to visit Amsterdam city & Glass Topped canal cruise famous for Amsterdam 88 canals. A cruise along Amsterdam's picture-book canals... it's something not to be missed! Cruising through a number of Amsterdam's canals, this cruise passes along some of the city's most beautiful spots. While gliding through the old centre of the city you see elegant merchant's mansions, carillon-crowned churches and the warehouses with their rich history from Holland's Golden Age.

Day 05 : Amsterdam - Cologne.

After a continental breakfast at the hotel, board your coach and drive into Cologne. Visit the Impressive Cologne Cathedral, a fine example of amazing Gothic architecture. Today evening, enjoy a delicious Indian dinner.

Day 06 : Cologne – Black Forest – Zurich.

After breakfast we will check out and proceed for Black Forest and visit Cockku Clock Factory. The name black forest was quite accurate in earlier times, when the forest was impenetrable though profitable - wood, silver and ore were the foundations of the Black Forest's inhabitants comparable wealth. When the wood trade began to falter clock-making stepped in and has been a successful industry for the Black Forest ever since the 17th century. Later proceed for Zurich where you will enjoy delicious Indian Dinner.

Day 07 : Rhine Falls – Zurich city tour.

After breakfast we will proceed to view the magnificent Rhine Falls. Europe's largest waterfall. They are truly magnificent, not so much for their height (a mere 23m) as for their impressive breadth (150m) and the sheer drama of the place, with the spray rising in a cloud of rainbows above the forested banks. August 1 – the Swiss National Day – is particularly impressive, with a huge fireworks display mounted on the riverside. Later depart for Zurich city tour. Discover this unique city, see the castle-like National Museum, the shopping and business centre on Bahnhofstrasse, the Limmatquai with its medieval Old Town and view to the Lindenhof, where the brave women of Zurich saved the city from the invaders, the beautiful Zurich lake (picture stop). Enjoy delicious Indian Dinner.

Day 08 : Grindelwald – Jungfrau – Interlaken – Grindelwald.

This morning, after a continental breakfast, proceed for an adventurous ride to visit Jungfrauoch – the Top of Europe, for a memorable encounter with snow and ice. You will be amazed at the scenic splendour that you see from aboard the ‘cog-wheel’ train, which takes you to a height of 3,454 meters to reach Jungfrauoch! Visit the Ice Palace on top of the longest glacier in the Alps. A visit to the Sphinx is also included. Later, we visit Interlaken, a charming city nestled between two lakes and surrounded by the splendid Bernese Oberland Mountains. Treasure these wonderful moments as you drive back to your hotel.

Day 09 : Grindelwald – Engelberg – Lucerne - Grindelwald.

After a continental breakfast at your hotel, we take you on one of the most memorable experiences of your Europe tour – visiting Mt. Titlis and Lucerne. Adventure awaits you in a sensational cable-car ride up to Mt. Titlis. Marvel at the world’s first revolving cable-car ride, a truly once-in-a-lifetime experience. Remain spellbound as you ascend the snow-clad mountains. Experience the snow and ice on top of Mt. Titlis, also a chance to ride, ‘Ice Flyer’. At 3,020 meters a breathtaking panorama unfolds. Next, we proceed to scenic Lucerne, where you will have an opportunity to visit the Lion Monument and the Kapell Brucke (wooden bridge). You will have some free time to shop for some famous Swiss watches, knives and chocolates. Board your coach for return back to Grindelwald.

Day 10 : Grindelwald – Innsbruck (Austria) – Swarovski Crystal Showroom & Museum.

After breakfast we will check out & proceed for Innsbruck. After lunch, we drive through the Inn Valley to Wattens to visit the world famous Swarovski Crystal Worlds, where you can admire crystal works of art by many famous artists (e.g. Salvador Dali). Experience a view of the surreal landscape of a glittering galaxy, the inside of a crystal dome with changing patterns of light and sound. Later afternoon visit Innsbruck. Visit Berg Isel ski jump, Wilten Basilica, Maria-Theresien-Street and the Old Town, with its famous Golden Roof. Later depart to your hotel and enjoy Indian dinner.

Day 11 : Innsbruck – Venice - Padova.

After a continental breakfast at the hotel, drive to Venice. On arrival at the pier, board a boat to proceed to the heart of the traditional city of Venice – The St. Mark’s Square. Admire the St. Mark’s square with the Basilica, the Doge’s Palace, the Campanile and the Bridge of Sighs. Also visit the Murano Glass showroom. Later, drive towards Padova. Tonight, enjoy a delicious Indian dinner.

Day 12 : Padova – Pisa - Florence - Montecatini (Italy).

This morning, after a continental breakfast at your hotel, sit back and relax in your coach as we drive you to Pisa. We take you to Pisa to visit the Square of Miracles. Remain spellbound as you approach this precariously leaning tower. Later after Lunch, we drive you to Florence – the capital of Tuscany. See the Duomo, the Campanile, the Baptistery with its gates to Paradise. The famous Ponte Vecchio Bridge across the river Arno and the Piazzale Michelangelo with the impressive statue of David. In the evening depart towards beautiful Montecatini, where we have our overnight star. Enjoy Indian Dinner.

Day 13 : Montecatini – Rome - Guided city tour of Rome.

After a continental breakfast in your hotel, sit back and relax in your coach as we drive to Rome. On arrival proceed with an English- speaking guide to the Vatican City – the smallest country in the world. Visit the holy basilica of St. Peter’s – the incomparable home of architectural and artistic masterpieces by Michelangelo and Bernini which will leave you awestruck. Next, see the Colosseum known for its gladiator fights. Later, discover many of the renowned attractions of Rome – the Victor Emmanuel monument on Piazza Venezia under which lies the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Circus Maximums known for its chariot races, the ancient ruins of Roman Forum and many more. Stop by the largest and most elaborate fountain – The Trevi fountain. A wish here can bring you back to Rome. Tonight, enjoy an Indian dinner.

Day 14 : Rome – India.

After breakfast check out & depart to Airport. Board your return flight to your onward destination.
