

# **Scandinavia 08 Days**

## **Day 1: India – Helsinki (Finland)**

Arrive at Helsinki airport where you will meet your local representative. Pick up by coach and transfer to the hotel. Welcome to Helsinki, the capital of the Republic of Finland, is a modern city with over half a million residents and is situated on the Baltic Sea. Over 450 years of history, several architectural layers and the impact of different periods can be clearly seen in Helsinki. Finnish design has also made the country's capital city world famous. The beauty of the surrounding nature blends seamlessly together with high-tech achievements, while old traditions mix with the latest contemporary trends. The city centre has many beautiful parks, and the nearby forests offer an ideal setting for peaceful and quiet walks. Helsinki's rhythm is laid back yet at the same time refreshingly active in terms of both the number and quality of restaurants and nightclubs. Everything is nearby – Helsinki is a pocket-sized metropolis that is ideal for visitors!

## **Day 2: Helsinki-Stockholm**

After breakfast at your hotel, Morning free at leisure. Meet with your private English speaking guide after lunch for a 3 hours sightseeing tour. Tour includes the Senate Square, Sibelius Park with monument, Temppeliaukio Rock Church, the Market Place, Kaivopuisto viewpoint, Olympic Stadium, Uspenski Cathedral, outside look of National Museum, Parliament, Observatory Park, Helsinki University and Helsinki Cathedral. Later departure to Stockholm by Viking Line at 17.00.

## **Day 3: Stockholm**

Breakfast will be served on board. Arrive in Stockholm in the morning by Viking Line. Pick up by coach and guide for 3 h city sightseeing in Stockholm including the Old Town, the Royal Palace built in 1754, entrance to City Hall and a photo stop at Fjällgatan. After lunch day is free at leisure, where you can explore on your own.

## **Day 4: Stockholm – Oslo**

After breakfast at your hotel, Pick up by private coach for transfer to Oslo via Karlstad. Karlstad is situated between Stockholm and Oslo, where the Klarälven River flows into Lake Vänern from the north. Being the seat of the Värmland county government, Karlstad is the centre of the entire region. The municipality of Karlstad has approximately 84,000 inhabitants, but the greater Karlstad area, including four adjacent municipalities, is the home of some 130,000 people. There are many shopping opportunities in Karlstad. The flourishing city centre has small boutiques, outdoor cafés and a new multi-storey indoor shopping centre. Arrive in Oslo in the evening.

## **Day 5: Oslo- Flåm – Geilo**

After breakfast at your hotel, Pick up by coach in the morning for transfer to Flåm in the fjords. Upon arrival you will take a fjord ferry along beautiful Sognefjord to Gudvangen. The greatest attraction of the Sognefjord is its immense variety of landforms gathered in one and the same region - from wide-open fjord landscapes and green hills to narrow fjord arms, massive mountain ranges and spectacular blue glaciers - creating the natural settings for small, idyllic fruit-growing villages, modern communities and isolated mountain farms. You will see all of this while cruising. Later meet your coach in Gudvangen and transfer to Geilo.

## **Day 6: Geilo – Oslo**

After breakfast at your hotel, Pick up by coach and transfer to Oslo via Nes. Upon arrival in Oslo you will meet with an English speaking guide for a 3-hour guided tour including Vigeland Park, Karl Johan shopping street, outside look of the Royal Palace and City Hall.

## **Day 7: Oslo – Copenhagen.**

After breakfast at your hotel, Pick up by coach for transfer to Copenhagen via Gothenburg. Gothenburg has built a bright new global reputation as one of Northern Europe's most exciting and above all enjoyable gastronomic hubs. Gothenburg is a friendly and pleasant city of convenient size, where most of the many sights and attractions of international magnitude are located within easy walking distance, as are most shops, restaurants and cafés. After

lunch in Gothenburg coach continues to Helsingborg from where you will take the ferry to Helsingör. Arrival in Copenhagen late afternoon.

### Day 8: Copenhagen – India.

After breakfast at your hotel, meet with coach and English speaking guide for 3 hours sightseeing including Little Mermaid, Gifon fountain in the Langlin Park, outside look of Amalienborg Palace (incl the Royal guard change if time allows). Christiansborg and the Parliament and outside look of the Opera house, Nyhavn, Strøget pedestrian street etc, statue of HC Andersen in Radhuspladsen. Transfer to the airport in the afternoon for flight back home.
