

Spain / Portugal / Morocco 14 days

Day 01 : Madrid

Meet and Greet upon arrival and transfer to your hotel. Check in hotel (1400hrs).

Day 02 : Madrid City Tour

After breakfast at the hotel, depart for Madrid city tour. During tour, we will visit the oldest districts in Madrid: Austria, Plaza Mayor, Retiro Park, the Borbones area (Royal Palace, Prado Museum, Cibeles fountain, 'Puerta de Alcalá') and Isabel's.

Day 03 : Madrid / Segovia / Avila / Salamanca

After breakfast at the hotel and departure in bus with a tour escort to Segovia, stop to admire the Roman aqueduct. The ancient Roman aqueduct in Segovia is not a religious site, but it is such a magnificent monument that we just can't bear to leave it out of our guide. The most visited and photographed sight in Segovia and the symbol of the city, its massive scale and state of. Preservation are unmatched anywhere in Europe. Next stop in Avila where St Theresa founded the order of Carmelites, then overnight in Salamanca where you can admire the baroque Plaza Mayor one of the biggest in Spain.

Day 04 : Salamanca / Coimbra

After breakfast and departure to Ciudad Rodrigo and the Portuguese Border and continue via Guarda towards Coimbra , site of one of the oldest university of Europe and birth place of the Fado, the music of Portugal. This city holds a special place in the hearts of all the Portuguese. Rich in its history and is the oldest seat of learning in Portugal with a University founded on the 13th of August in 1290 by King *Dinis*. This makes it one of the oldest in the world. *Coimbra* was liberated from Moor occupation in 1064 and was then developed as a town by the capable *Conde de Sesmundo* who was the master here for 27 years. Six of Portugal's Kings were born here and between 1139 and 1256 it was the chosen capital of the country.

Day 05 : Coimbra / Fatima / Lisbon.

After breakfast, departure to Fatima , important pilgrimage center , free time to visit the basilica of Fatima. Our Lady of Fátima is a title given to the Blessed Virgin Mary with respect to reported apparitions of her to three shepherd children at Fátima in Portugal on the 13th day of six consecutive months in 1917, starting on May 13. The three children were Lúcia Santos and her cousins, siblings Jacinta and Francisco Marto. The title of *Our Lady of the Rosary* is also sometimes used in reference to the same apparition, because the children related that the apparition specifically identified herself as the "Lady of the Rosary". It is also common to see a combination of these titles, i.e. Our Lady of the Rosary of Fátima. The events at Fatima gained particular fame due to their elements of prophecy and eschatology, particularly with regard to possible world war and the conversion of Russia. The reported apparitions at Fatima were officially declared "worthy of belief" by the Catholic Church. Afterwards, continuation to Lisbon , located at the mouth of river Tagus.

Day 06 : Salamanca / Fatima / Lisbon.

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Day 07 : Lisbon

After breakfast at the hotel and sightseeing tour of Lisbon with a local guide to discover this city : Belem Tower, Jeronimos monastery and the charming old quarters of Alfama and Bairro Alto and its small cobblestone streets. Afternoon & evening at leisure.

Day 08 : Lisbon / Seville

After breakfast and departure to Seville, through Extremadura (Badajoz). Seville is located in the South of Spain. A provincial capital, seat of the government and parliament of the Comunidad Autónoma de Andalucía (Regional Government). It has more than 700,000 inhabitants, nearly half the population of the whole province. The city of Seville is located on the plain of the Guadalquivir River which crosses the city from North to South. The river can be navigated from Seville all the way to its outlet near Sanlúcar de Barrameda, on the Atlantic coast. In the past the port of Seville played an important role in commerce between Spain and the Americas and it remains today one of the most active river ports of the Iberian Peninsula.

Day 09 : Seville

After breakfast and city tour of Seville with local guide to visit the Cathedral and the Santa Cruz Quarter and a panoramic tour including: expo's areas (Cartuja island) and park de Maria Luisa , the Golden Tower. Be seduced by Seville on a leisurely afternoon tour of this Andalusian gem. Built on the banks of the Guadalquivir River, lively Seville has a rich Arab legacy and colourful local districts such as Triana and La Macarena. Your tour continues with a visit to the famous pavilions and bridges of the 1992 Universal Exhibition, and the Carthusian monastery where Columbus prepared for his voyages of discovery.

Day 10 : Sevilla – Tangier

After breakfast, depart through the sunny sherry wine region of Jerez to Algeciras. Ferry to Ceuta, across the frontier and visit of Tetuan. The history of Tangier is very rich due to the historical presence of many civilizations and cultures starting from the 5th century BC. Between the period of being a Phoenician town to the independence era around the 1950s, Tangier was a place —and, sometimes a refuge— for many cultures. However, it was not until 1923 that Tangier was attributed an international status by foreign colonial powers, thus becoming a destination for many Europeans and non-Europeans such as Americans and Indians alike. Lunch in a restaurant in the Medina and free time.

Day 11 : Tangier – Costa Del Sol

After breakfast and visit of Tangier with the local guide and return to Algeciras by ferry. First is an hour and half panoramic tour through different areas of the new Tangier showing you the living sections of different communities that lived in the city during the international administration (1923-1956), drive through residential sections with its hundreds of luxurious residences and palaces and end up at Spartel Cape (a meeting point of the Mediterranean and the Atlantic) in Africa. Then drive to the Costa del Sol where you will have your.

Day 12 : Costa Del Sol – Granada

After breakfast departure to Granada, arrival and meeting with a local guide to visit the Alhambra. The Alhambra's Moorish palaces were built for the last Muslim Emirs in Spain and its court, of the Nasrid dynasty. After the Reconquista by the Reyes Católicos ("Catholic Monarchs") in 1492, some portions were used by the Christian rulers. The Palace of Charles V, built by Charles V, Holy Roman Emperor in 1527, was inserted in the Alhambra within the Nasrid fortifications. After being allowed to fall into disrepair for centuries, the Alhambra was "discovered" in the 19th century by European scholars and travellers, with restorations commencing. It is now one of Spain's major tourist attractions, exhibiting the country's most significant and well known Islamic architecture, together with 16th-century and later Christian building and garden interventions. The Alhambra is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the inspiration for many songs and stories.

Day 13 : Granada / Toledo / Madrid

After breakfast drive to Toledo, visit with a local guide including the synagogue , the Gothic Cathedral etc. Toledo's architecture and twisting streets have received many historical and cultural influences over the centuries and the city rightly deserves its title of a national monument. The city's wide ranging attractions appeal to tourists from all walks of life and so it is fair to say that there will be something to suit everyone visiting Toledo.

Day 14 : Madrid – India.

After breakfast, the day at leisure to visit a museum or discover the city on your own and to enjoy your last day in Spain, Depending on the flight timings proceed to Airport to board your flight to Mumbai.
